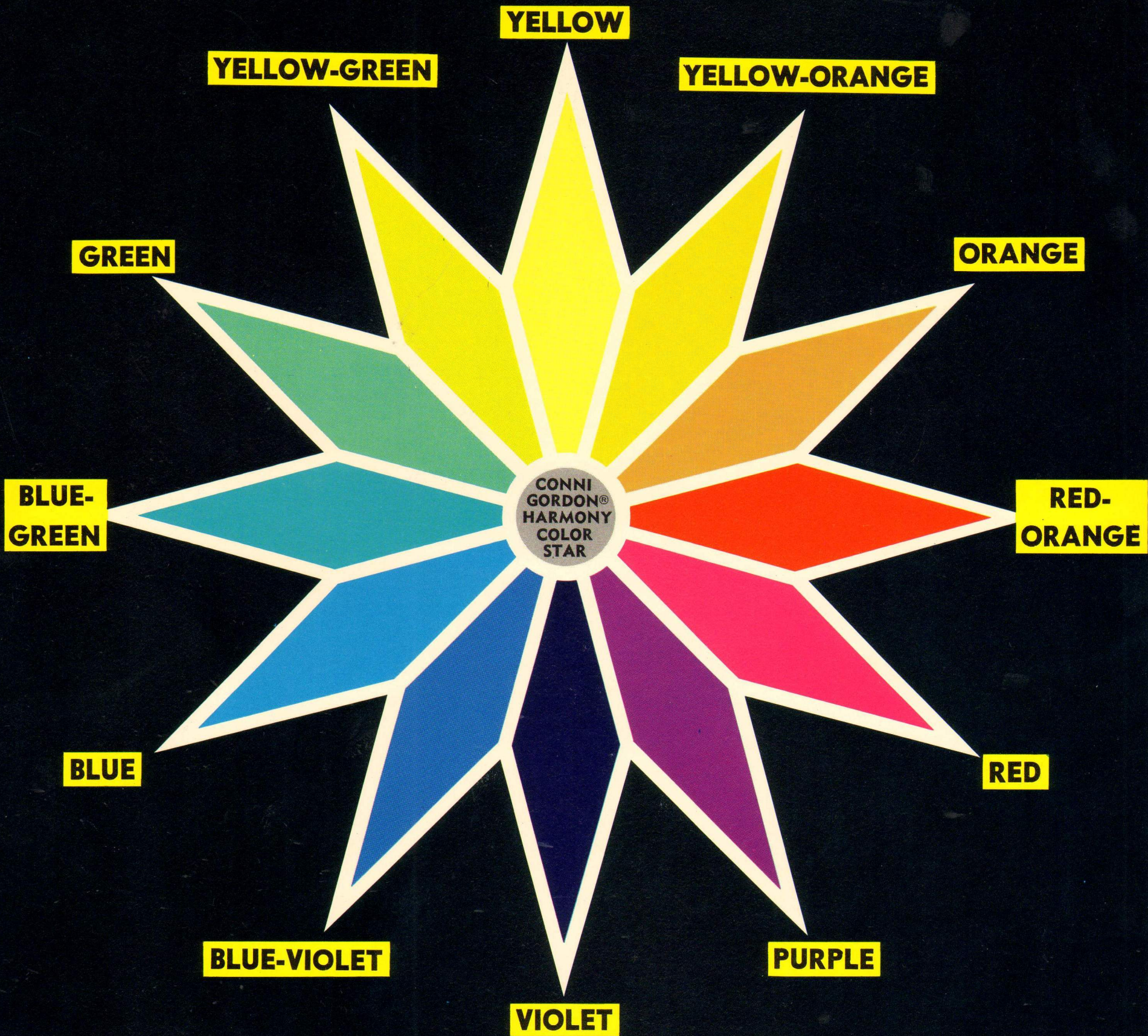
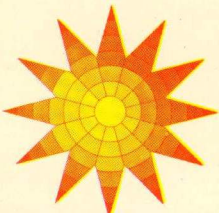


HARMONY COLOR STAR

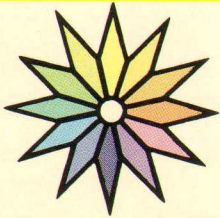


GUIDE TO COLOR HARMONY



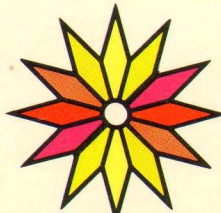
ONE HUE DOMINATES

Use more of **ONE** color with tints, tones, shades (Called Monochromatic)
or
Use more **NEIGHBORING** colors related by common hue (Called Analogous)
or
Use more of **one** color than its **OPPOSITE** on Color-Star (Called Complementary color plan)



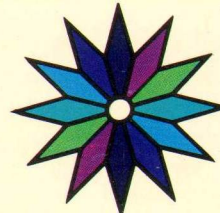
ONE VALUE DOMINATES

Use more **LIGHT** colors (High on Star or tints)
or
Use more **MEDIUM** colors (Mid Star colors or tones)
or
Use more **DARK** colors (Low on Star or shades)



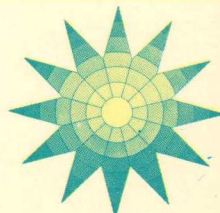
ONE INTENSITY DOMINATES

Use more **BRIGHT** color (purer)
or
Use more **DULL** color (grayer mixtures)



ONE STRENGTH DOMINATES

Use more **STRONG** color
or
Use more **WEAK** color



ONE TONE DOMINATES

Use more **YELLOW-ORANGES** (Called Warm tones)
or
Use more **BLUE-GREENS** (Called Cool tones)
